The United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime presents its compliments to the Permanent Mission of Spain to the United Nations (Vienna) and is pleased to bring to its attention the call for proposals for the 2018 DAPC grants. DAPC grants will be awarded, in the context of the UNODC Youth Initiative, for substance use prevention activities targeting youth.

DAPC grants are aimed to benefit not-for-profit organisations working with youth in low- and middle-income countries, to initiate drug use prevention activities both targeting and involving youth. The supported activities should utilize prevention approaches based on evidence, as summarized in the International Standards on Drug Use Prevention (<http://www.unodc.org/unodc/en/drug-prevention-and-treatment/publications.html>), and empower youth to take more active roles in their communities for better youth health, in line with the UNODC Youth Initiative.

The funds for the DAPC grants are raised, and generously donated to UNODC by the youth in the Drug Abuse Prevention Centre (DAPC) in Japan, and the Prevention, Treatment and Rehabilitations Section is annually awarding them in the context of the UNODC Youth Initiative.

The relevant organisations are kindly asked to submit proposals to the email address unodc-youthinitiative@un.org no later than 13 July, midnight (GMT+2 hours). Please note that no exception can be made to this deadline.
